COVID-19 update from Department of Education and Training

- ➤ It is strongly recommended that everyone wears a face mask in all indoor and crowded places.
- ➤ Household contacts of a confirmed COVID-19 case must continue to wear a mask indoors, unless an exception applies.
- ➤ The Australian Health Protection Principle Committee has reduced the period to consider someone as a recently confirmed case from 12 weeks to 4 weeks.
- ➤ The Victorian Government has also launched a 'Stay Well in Winter' campaign to encourage 3rd and 4th COVID-19 vaccine doses along with flu vaccination.

New Financial Year Brings New Changes for International Students

With the start of a new financial year in Australia, several changes are made to the international students.

- ➤ An increase in the student visa fee to \$650
- ➤ An increase in the minimum wage by 5.2%, making the new minimum wage \$21.38 cents per hour.
- ➤ An increase in the percentage of superannuation guarantee from 10% to 10.5%
- ➤ Every one will receive superannuation payments regardless of how much they earn as long as they are all above 18 years of age and work more than 30 hours a month.
- ➤ The Australian government is giving temporary graduate visa holders additional time to stay in Australia.
- ➤ Temporary skills shortage visa holders can now access a new pathway to get hold of the Australian Permanent residency.
