AVETMISS data reporting

It is a national data standard. All registered RTOs need to collect and report AVETMISS data on accredited training activity. This is TVA (total VET activity).

Why?

- To ensure consistency and accuracy of VET information
- RTOs can use the AVETMISS statistics for their business, can benchmark their RTO.
- Number of NCVER reports and data can be accessed for free from AVETMISS portal.



How?

- Collect enrolment data from students
- USI (Unique Student Identifier) is a mandatory field for reporting nationally, collect and verify student's USI.
- RTO;s have to upload that data into AVETMISS compliant student management system (SMS)
- File validation takes place through NCVER's AVETMISS validation software. (AVS).
- Once your data is validated error free, it must be submitted via AVS for fee-for-service training activity
 or through relevant state training authority for government funded training activity.

USI - Unique Student Identifier

A USI is an individual education number given to a student for life. It gives the student an online record of their VET taken in Australia. An USI is mandatory to get Commonwealth financial assistance or to a receive a qualification or to get statement of attainment.
