Apprentices and trainees 2022: September quarter

Apprentices and trainees 2022: September quarter provides a national picture of apprenticeship and traineeship activity, including both quarterly and annual figures that can be broken down by state and territory.



NCVER (National Centre for Vocational Education Research) are the main provider of research, statistics and data on Australia's VET sector. Their latest data show that there were 402 245 apprentices and trainees in training as of 30th sep 2022, which ic 14% higher when compared to previous data from 2021. Apprentice and trainee completions increased to 24 655 in the September quarter 2022, up 33.4% from the same quarter in 2021. Completions in trade occupations drove most of the increase in September quarter 2022.
